SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION - 2024

One graduating member of the Class of 202th from each of the following schools -Westerly High School and Chariho High School-

will be selected to receive a Scholarship in the amount of \$1000.00 each.

The following requirements must be met for an application to be qualified for consideration of The American Legion, H.W. Merrill Post 16 Scholarship.

- Applicants must identify at least one relative who has received an Honorable Discharge from the United States Armed Forces (any branch), or is presently serving in the United States military. (*Eligible relatives*: Sibling, Parent, Aunt, Uncle, Grandparent)
- 2. Applicants must be students in good standing, who will be graduating with the Class of 2024 of either Westerly High School, or Chariho High School.
- Applicants must submit two (2) letters of recommendation from individuals who are
 qualified to specifically discuss your achievements within the community, your
 achievements in school, as well as your personal qualities of citizenship.
 References may NOT be written by members of your family, or other students.
- 4. Applicants must submit a well-constructed essay of no fewer than 500 words on the following topic: "DO YOU THINK OUR CURRENT TWO-PARTY POLITICAL SYSTEM IN THE UNITED STATES IS VIABLE? IF YOUR OPINION IS 'YES,' EXPLAIN WHY. IF YOUR OPINION IS 'NO,' EXPLAIN WHY."
 - Essays will be evaluated on the basis of English Skills/Format/Readability, Subject Content, Thoughtfulness, and Uniqueness of your writing.
- 5. Applicants must submit a copy of their current official high school transcript.
- Applicants must submit all parts of this Scholarship Application to their respective Guidance Department no later than the date stipulated by the counselor in charge.
