- Information on your artistic point of view
 What interests you? What is your artwork about?
- Motivations for pursuing a career in the arts
- Academic and artistic goals

4. Portfolio of five strongest original artworks

- Submit your five strongest original artworks
 - Artworks will be judged on Concept Development, Application of the Elements of Art and Principles of Design, Creativity/Problem Solving, and Craftsmanship
- o Artwork can be
 - two-dimensional (drawings, paintings, collages, etc.)
 - three-dimensional (ceramics, sculpture)
 - digital art (graphic design work, photographs, or videos)

How to submit: Take quality photos of any two-dimensional or three-dimensional artwork. Place all 5 selected original artworks in a google drive folder and submit the link to that folder <u>in your application</u>. Adjust share settings to "Anyone with the link **can view**"
