This scholarship was formerly known as the Benefit Concert Scholarship, which was started in March of 2022, at the first Benefit Concert after the Covid pandemic. The scholarship was funded by donations collected at the annual chorus Benefit Concert. Since the Benefit Concert did not take place this year, Mrs. Lynn Dowding and her husband have graciously offered to fund the scholarship award.

This scholarship will be open to all seniors who have a passion for music and who have given their time and talents to help others by demonstrating leadership, participating in past concerts and providing music for our community. You do not have to be pursuing a career in music to apply for this scholarship, but have plans to keep music in your life in some form in the future. Applications will be due on April 1st, and presented at the annual Scholarship Awards night. Winners will be selected anonymously based on their responses to the questions on the application by a committee of teachers.
