

Chariho Centennial Lions Club Scholarship Fund – 2024 Award



The Chariho Centennial Lions Club Scholarship Fund is offering two \$500 scholarship awards.

The motto of the Lions Club International is “We Serve.” Founded in 1917, the Lions are best known for saving sight, but also feed the hungry, aid seniors and the disabled, care for the environment and so much more. Lions are a global service network of volunteers that make a difference in their local communities.

The Chariho Centennial Lions Club Scholarship was started in 2017 by a group of local residents looking to aid and serve our neighbors in Charlestown, Richmond, and Hopkinton. The Chariho Centennial Lions Club Scholarship Fund seeks to encourage and reward local students for their active community service. The applicant must be a graduating senior of Chariho Regional High School.

The scholarship can be used by the student to pay for education expenses at a two or four-year college or a vocational program. The Chariho Centennial Lions Club Scholarship Fund was established with fundraising efforts and donations to the Chariho Centennial Lions Club.

The applicant is required to submit a written application. The scholarship will be awarded based on the recommendations of an independent committee and will be contingent upon the applicant’s acceptance at a two- or four-year college or vocational program (any major is acceptable). The funds will be dispersed directly to the scholarship recipient.

Applications may be obtained through the guidance office of the Chariho Regional High School. The applications must be submitted to the guidance office of the Chariho Regional High School by March 29, 2024.
