Each year, the USJCI Senate Foundation grants \$1,000.00 scholarships to high school seniors who plan to continue their education at accredited post-secondary colleges, universities or career/technical schools. The number of grants awarded annually is at the discretion of the Foundation and must be used for educational expenses in the first year of full time study. Checks awarded will be made out to the name of the recipient and the educational institution of the recipient's choice.
